## REVIEW: K FUSION HAIR SMOOTHING TREATMENT

There are a number of ways to straighten **Afro hair** blow-drying, relaxing, and of course using straighteners. A **Brazilian blow dry**, though, was never a viable option in my mind. I doubted its ability to straighten out the super-kinks that my hair possesses, and worrying stories about dengerously high levels of chemicals involved cemented my concerns. I ruled it out.

However, that all changed when I came across the **K Fusion Hair Smoothing Treatment**. It's a Brazilian blow dry treatment with a difference: it's 100% formaldehyde free, packed full of protein and hydrolysed keratin, and infused with argan oil. Sounds good, but is it for Afro hair I asked? After seeing before and after pics I was sold.

Ready for the treatment, I headed down to the **Marlon Wright Hair Salon** in Twickenham, Middlesex on a blazing hot Saturday afternoon (4th July 2015).









I walked in with finger-detangled hair and mixed emotions. My nervousness was soon eased, however, as Marlon

First up was a good wash with **L'Kerabelle Clarifying Shampoo** followed by detangling. Marion made this look too easy as he used a **Tangle Teezer** to glide through the knots. Now ready, the treatment was applied painstakingly to my hair, starting at the nape. Then it was left to dry for 30 minutes.



After a quick rinse, my hair was blow-dried then flat ironed to lock down the cuticle and seal in the keratin treatment. Four hours later, I was able to see the full results that I had walted so long for. I now had shiny, superstraight hair link was soft to the touch and wowed everyone by the difference! But for how long I thought. With high-humidity levels that threatened to wreck havoc on any heat-styled hairdo it didn't look promising.
